St Michael's Mount, Marazion, Cornwall

This romantic Cornish landmark is made up of a granite crag on a tidal island in Mount's Bay, crowned by a medieval castle and chapel, and linked to Marazion by a paved causeway. The chapel was built in 1135, and the 14th century castle has sub-tropical gardens sloping down to the sea and the pretty harbour.



This eye-catching half-timbered manor house, with tall brick chimneys, situated in a peaceful, isolated wooded valley in the English-Welsh border country, was built between 1380 and 1400. In the grounds is a small detached, timber-framed gatehouse across a moat, a lily pond and a ruined 12th century chapel.

Conwy Harbour, Conwy

Colourful fishing boats line the attractive harbour below Conwy Castle. The castle was built by Edward I between 1283 and 1289 in a strategic position to guard the Conwy estuary, with eight huge towers, a drawbridge and portcullis. The enormous town walls, with 21 horseshoe-shaped towers, encircle the town.

Dunstanburgh Castle, Northumberland

This dramatic ruined 14th century castle, the largest in Northumberland, stands on the clifftop near Craster, along a beautiful, remote stretch of coastline. Built between 1313 and 1332 by Thomas, Earl of Lancaster, it was a Lancastrian stronghold during the Wars of the Roses, but was damaged beyond repair in 1464.

John Webb's Windmill, Thaxted, Essex

Dating from 1804, this prominent tower mill is the only remaining windmill in the historic hilltop town of Thaxted, built on land owned by John Webb. The mill helped to satisfy a growing demand for flour at a time of agricultural expansion, it is the largest of the four Thaxted mills and worked for 100 years.

Near Hayfield, Derbyshire

Snow-clad moorland with farmland pastures below, is seen from the summit of Lantern Pike (373m). Its name probably comes from its use as a beacon in the past. The hill is popular with hikers and is often considered a continuation of Kinder Scout, the vast moorland plateau whose highest point is 636m.
