Finland

Large, powerful and generally solitary, the brown bear feeds opportunistically, using paws and long claws to root out plants, fruit and insects and to catch salmon. For 2-3 years the cubs are closely supervised by their mother, travelling with her over long distances and learning techniques for fishing and finding food to become independent.

These slender, graceful and gregarious deer roam the savanna and grassland in large herds to forage and graze. They can leap up to 10m and jump 3m in the air. If startled, the whole herd will start leaping about to confuse a predator. The males have long lyre-shaped horns. The young are cared for and protected in nursery groups by the herd.

This attractive small toucan of tropical lowland forests is usually found in small groups of 6-15 individuals, moving through the canopy of fruiting trees or seen flying across clearings and between trees and roosting communally. It has glossy black upperparts and yellow body with red and black markings, and a serrated pattern on its big bill.

They migrate 25,000km a year, feeding on krill in cooler, high-latitude waters and breeding in subtropical waters. The males are known for their 'singing'- a series of calls repeated for several hours possibly to attract females.

Nepal

These elusive, rare cats have adapted to survive in the harsh Himalayan environment, with wide, fur-covered feet for walking on deep snow, a powerful body and a thick grey-white rosetted coat for warmth and camouflage. Youngsters tussle and play-fight to prepare them for adult life and stay with their mother for 18-22 months before dispersing.

AFRICAN FOREST ELEPHANT
Central African Republic

Inhabiting the dense rainforests of west and central Africa, forest elephants are smaller than savanna elephants, with oval-shaped ears and straighter tusks; they also have a much slower reproductive rate. They live in family groups and forage on leaves, grasses, seeds, fruit, and tree bark, playing a crucial role in dispersing many tree species.

RED-EYED TREE FROG
Central America

This colourful, arboreal amphibian with big red eyes and a bright green, blue and yellow body lives in rainforests and humid lowlands. It is very small, up to 8cm long and has long red and orange limbs and strong suction toe pads to jump and climb trees and cling onto leaves. If disturbed, it will abruptly open its red eyes to startle a predator.

WOMBAT
Tasmania

Wombats are among the world's largest burrowing animals. They have a stocky body, powerful limbs, short broad feet and flattened claws. They are primarily grazers, using their continuously growing incisors to cut grass and rushes in heathland, coastal scrub, and open forest. Many wombats usually live in the same burrow for their whole lifespan.

Trinidad and Tobago

French angelfish are foragers and eat a variety of invertebrates and plants. Juveniles clean parasites and loose scales off large fishes, including some that are predatory. French angelfish typically forage in pairs, which they form for mating and to jointly defend a feeding territory from other fishes. They reproduce only with their partner.

Ethiopia

Endemic to the Highlands of Ethiopia, only at altitudes of 1,800-4,400m, gelada are highly social grazers and, due to the lack of large trees at this altitude, are not arboreal. By day they forage the plateau's grasslands before descending at night to narrow cliff edges. They have coiffed fur and the male has a bright patch of skin on its chest.

It is highly adaptable to different habitats and an opportunistic hunter, stalking its prey though undergrowth, rocky and open areas, mainly at dusk or night.

CHINSTRAP PENGUIN
Antarctica

These medium penguins with a thin black 'chinstrap' under the head migrate north of the pack ice to catch krill, their staple food out at sea. Each spring they return to the same nesting sites to breed on rocky islands, often squabbling noisily in the colony. Both parents take turns to incubate the two eggs laid in a circular nest of stones.
