

MALAYAN TIGER LATA BERKOH, THE KUALA TAHAN NATIONAL PARK, PAHANG, MALAYSIA

This critically endangered tiger is a subspecies native to Peninsular Malaysia. The Malayan Tiger's main diet consists of smaller prey, especially deer. It is an excellent swimmer that loves the water. However, development projects and agriculture have fragmented its habitat. Vast areas of its natural forest habitat have been lost due to large-scale palm oil production. Commercial poaching is also a threat due to a domestic market for tiger meat and tiger bone medicines. Each tiger's unique stripe pattern aids identification in conservation projects.

CHIMPANZEE

EKOM FALLS, CAMEROON

Highly intelligent and social, chimpanzees live in deciduous forests and rainforests in communities of between 15 to 150 members, but most of their time is spent travelling in small groups. Their diet is primarily fruit, leaves, bark and stems, which they collect in the trees. They are classified as endangered – their habitat is lost through deforestation, to provide room for a rapidly rising human population. Poaching for the illegal bushmeat and pet trade is another threat. Because they share 98% of our DNA, they can also succumb to human diseases.

POLAR BEAR

BARTER ISLAND, KAKTOVIK, ALASKA

Generally solitary and supremely adapted to life on the Arctic ice floes, with large, furry, partially webbed paws to help them walk on the ice and swim, polar bears depend on sea ice to hunt seals, their staple diet. While they have no predators, they are classed as vulnerable due to climate change. As the ice cap melts, and the sea ice gets thinner, they must travel further to access seals. Malnutrition leads to a lower reproductive rate and reduced survival rate of cubs. Other hazards include chemical pollutants which get into the food chain.

MADAGASCAR FISH EAGLE RIVER TSIRIBIHINA, MADAGASCAR

This eagle is endemic to the coastal strip in northwest Madagascar, inhabiting rocky shores, lakes, rivers, mangrove swamps, and wooded areas - it depends on large trees for perches and nesting. About 63cm long, it has a pale brown head, dark brown body and white tail. Populations are declining and its conservation status is critically endangered. The main threats to its breeding are habitat destruction from deforestation, soil erosion and development of wetland areas for rice paddies, as well as persecution and competition with humans for fish stocks.

VANCOUVER ISLAND MARMOT STRATHCONA PROVINCIAL PARK, VANCOUVER ISLAND, CANADA

The only species of marmot endemic to Vancouver Island, distinguishable from other marmots by its chocolate brown fur and contrasting white patches, these marmots are very social animals, living in burrows in sub-alpine meadows. They need a soil structure suitable for constructing burrows and enough grass and other vegetation for food. They are critically endangered due to threats from climate change, which affects the availability of habitat after their long hibernation of around 210 days. Marmots also lose habitat when forested areas are clear-cut.

AFRICAN SAVANNA ELEPHANT ZIMANGA GAME RESERVE, KWAZULU-NATAL SOUTH AFRICA

The world's largest terrestrial animal, the African savanna elephant is about 3m high, weighing around six tons. Elephants travel in herds, often of four generations, led by a matriarch, whose excellent memory helps guide them long distances to find water and food. African savanna elephants have been assessed as vulnerable since 2021. They are still under significant threat from illegal ivory poaching from their tusks. Human encroachment has led to loss and fragmentation of their range.

Habitat management and law enforcement is aiding their survival.

WHALE SHARK CORAL BAY, NINGALOO REEF MARINE PARK, WESTERN AUSTRALIA

This filter-feeding shark inhabits the open waters of all tropical oceans and is the largest known fish species, measuring up to 18.8m, with a lifespan of 80-130 years. It feeds almost exclusively on plankton and poses no threat to humans. It has a broad, flat head with a huge mouth, which, unlike many other sharks, is set at the front rather than on the underside of the head. It is listed as endangered, due to a major reduction in population, primarily as a result of targeted fishing, bycatch in other fisheries, and collisions with large ships.

ASIATIC CHEETAH

MESR OASIS ON THE DASHT-E KAVIR DESERT,
NEAR KHUR CITY, IRAN

This very rare cheetah subspecies is critically endangered. It once roamed from Saudi Arabia to India but now survives only in protected areas in the east-central arid region of Iran, in extremely low numbers.

The fastest land mammal, it hunts by stealth and superior speed, though only in short bursts. Cheetahs require a lot of space - they are being forced to cross roads to access their large habitat and several are killed by cars. They are also being forced to share land with livestock, so

are in competition for limited food and water resources.

SPIX'S MACAW CABACEIRAS, PARAÍBA, BRAZIL

This distinctive parrot with a greyish head and vivid blue plumage was declared extinct in the wild in 2019. The main causes of its disappearance are poaching for the illegal trade of exotic pets and destruction of its habitat in the arid Caatinga vegetation (stunted trees, thorny shrubs and cacti), caused by deforestation, agricultural expansion, and mineral extraction. However, a very small population now survives through captive breeding and an ongoing reintroduction programme in two protected areas into the dry forest habitats in Bahia, Brazil.

SRI LANKAN SLOTH BEAR YALA NATIONAL PARK, SRI LANKA

Endemic to the north and eastern lowland forests of Sri Lanka, this sloth bear subspecies has much shorter body hair than the common sloth bear and is smaller in size. One of its main staples is insects, which it removes from rotting stumps and trees with its long, hairless snout. Otherwise, it rarely kills animals. It is highly threatened, surviving only in isolated populations, which are in decline because the dry-zone natural forests on which it depends are being destroyed. This habitat loss brings it closer to humans, with frequent conflicts.



MONARCH BUTTERFLY

EL ROSARIO

MONARCH BUTTERFLY RESERVE, MEXICO

Millions of resplendent monarch butterflies migrate about 2,500 miles from the USA and Canada to the oyamel fir forests of central Mexico, where they hibernate over winter. It is a perfect microclimate for these endangered butterflies to cluster together for warmth and protection. However, these unique ecosystems are being jeopardized by deforestation, illegal logging, and land-use changes in Mexico. In the US and Canada, the caterpillar's food plant is toxic milkweed leaves. Widespread pesticide use has led to a drastic loss of milkweed plants.

REINDEER TROMSØ NORWAY

Reindeer are native to Arctic, subarctic, tundra, boreal and mountainous regions of Northern Europe, Siberia, and North America (where they are known as caribou). Both males and females have antlers, grown each year. They feed on grass, leaves, herbs and lichen, digging through the snow during winter. They are classified as vulnerable - as the Arctic warms, vegetation patterns are shifting and reindeer need to adapt their range to the availability of food. Other threats include overhunting and ineffective land-use planning across their migratory routes.
